The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

Theme/Call To Worship

Sunday of the Most Holy Trinity celebrates the mystery of our God, revealed to us as three persons, one in being, and in full communion with one another, and challenges us to come to know God best through *relationships*.

Introduction To The Word

Exodus 34:4b-6, 8-9: In today's reading it is noteworthy to hear how God is characterized: "a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." Moses' reverence and humility before God, along with his apology for the sins of the Israelites, should be heard in the context of the blasphemy of the golden calf and the destruction of the first set of stone tablets.

2 Corinthians 13:11-13: This reading is taken from the concluding remarks in Paul's Second Letter to the Corinthians. It is a beautiful and calm ending to an otherwise very difficult letter. Throughout the letter, Paul defends himself against his opponents in Corinth who challenge his authority and status as an apostle. Despite the high emotions and troubling tone of the letter, Paul ends with words of encouragement for the congregation to live a holy and peaceful life with one another. The final words provide one of the New Testament's earliest Trinitarian formulas: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all."

John 3:16-18: The Gospel reading from John is one of the most well-known texts of the New Testament. It speaks not only to the intimacy and love between the Father and the Son, but also to the passion our God has for the world.
