**Bicenennial Fact...**Did you know that St. Patrick's Cathedral, located on Mulberry Street in Manhattan, was the city's first Cathedral Church? Dedicated on May 14, 1815, the church includes a labyrinth of mortuary vaults and a cemetery. Even so, in 1842, Bishop John Dubois, the third Bishop of New

York, was buried underneath the sidewalk in front of the Cathedral at his own request. This was supposedly so that he would be buried where the people could walk over him in death as they used to in life. Although St Patrick's Old Cathedral ceased to be the diocese seat in 1879, when the Cathedral of St. Patrick on Fifth Avenue was completed, it was ultimately one of the first sites to be named a New York City Landmark in 1966. Today St. Patrick's Old Cathedral is an active parish, serving a broad population in the heart of "Old New York".
