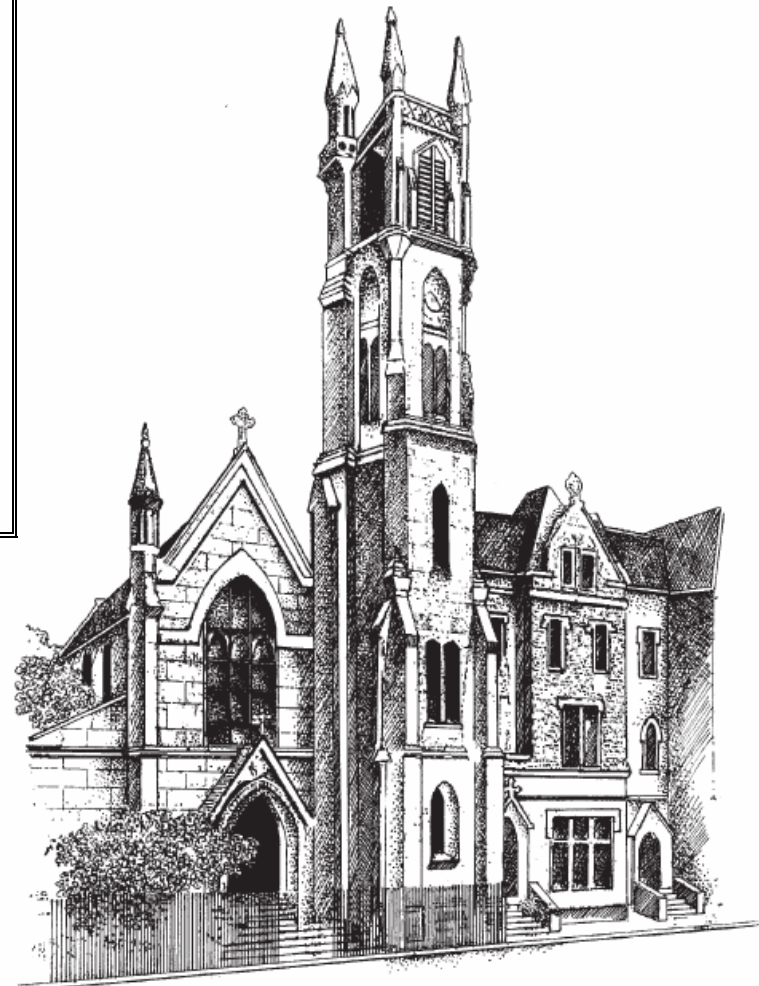

Easter Sunday – The Resurrection of the Lord

Theme/Call To Worship

Easter Sunday is the center of our church year because we celebrate today the central event in our salvation history. Virtually everything we profess about our Christian faith is built upon our belief that God raised Jesus from the dead.

Introduction To The Word

[Acts 10:34a, 37-43](#) : In the first reading from Acts, we hear from Peter “This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance.” Bearing witness to others of the belief in Jesus’ resurrection links the ancient and modern Christian. From the beginning almost all followers of Jesus were called to believe rather than to witness. It is our profession of faith in Easter Sunday that draws others to faith in Christ.

[Col 3:1-4 or I Cor 5:6b-8](#): The point of the second reading taken from St. Paul’s letter to the Corinthians is that our baptism unites us to Christ in both his death and resurrection.

[Lk 24: 13-35](#): The Gospel reading narrates the initial experience of the empty tomb. According to the fourfold Gospel tradition, Mary Magdalene was the first to discover the empty tomb and Peter’s initial reaction to the news of the empty tomb is skepticism and unbelief. Upon entering the tomb they “did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.” Only over time would Peter come to believe in Jesus’ resurrection.
