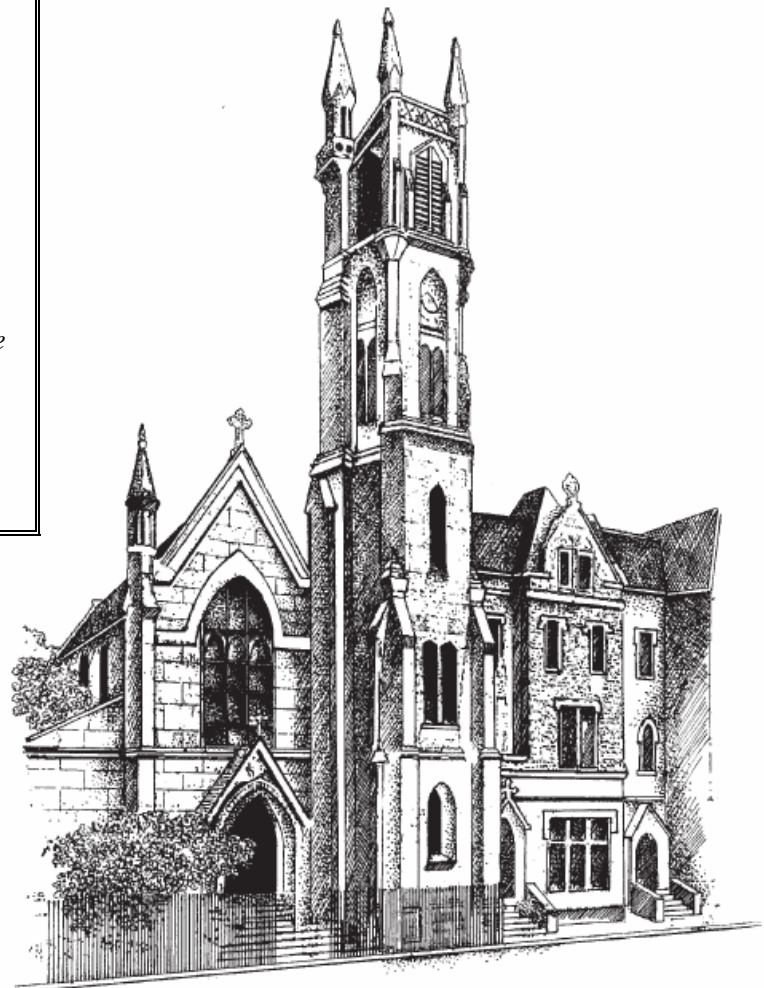

Theme/Call To Worship

All of Jesus' life and actions are directed toward his saving work culminating in his death and resurrection. Our response to Jesus is "to believe in him" and to demonstrate this belief through our daily actions.

Introduction To The Word

Is 62:1-5: In the first reading, the Prophet Isaiah speaks of the "glory" of God in the historical context of Israel's return from exile and speaks of Israel's "vindication" (freedom from the sin that led them into exile).

1 Cor 12:4-11: In the second reading St. Paul also speaks of the glory of God by describing the gifts the community receives from the Holy Spirit. Gifts that are used toward building up the body of Christ, a community of faith, united as one.

Jn 2:1-11: In today's Gospel St. John discusses the first miracle of Jesus' public ministry. The turning of water into wine at the wedding feast in Cana, the first of seven signs that show "the glory of the Father's only Son," signs that permit his disciples to witness Jesus' "glory" and enable them to begin their path toward belief.

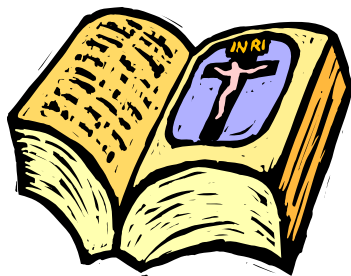
